## **Multilingual Dictionaries**

<u>glosbe</u>, bilingual dictionary for various languages, includes example sentences, human translations and automatic translations.

Wiktionary, a dictionary for many languages.

## **Communities**

<u>How to Learn Any Language</u>, contains popular forums for discussion of language learning

<u>LearnAnyLanguageWikia</u>, the goal of the wiki is to complement the forums at HTLAL. They want to rescue the nuggets of information that have been drowned in the flood of threads. The wiki contains pages on the methods, techniques, courses, problems and solutions that have been mentioned on the forum, distilling the best bits into a format that is more easily usable by everyone.

HelloTalk, mobile app for finding language partners

Hua, a mobile app that lets you chat in real-time with native speakers for free

<u>italki</u>, similar to mylanguageexchange where you can find native speakers to practice with and also has several social media tools. You can also find a personal teacher or tutor.

<u>Lang-8</u>, community where native speakers correct writings from learners

<u>mylanguageexchange</u>, site facilitating practice between native speakers and learners

<u>Forvo</u>, to have any word in any language pronounced by native speakers.

<u>InterPals</u>, more an international community to "meet people" than a learning site, although it can be used for both activities.
